The Department of Public Safety("DPS") collects the information on this form for identification and record keeping purposes as required by Minnesota Government Data Practices Act and Minn. Stat. § 13.04(2). Am I required to provide the requested information? You are not legally required to complete this form. What will happen if I do not provide the requested information? You can refuse and your data will continue to be restricted according to 18 U.S.C § 2721, however, you will not have the additional protection as stated in Minn. Stat. § 168.346(3). Who will have access to the requested information? DPS may disclose personal information when it relates to the operation or use of a vehicle or to public safety. The use of personal information relates to public safety if it concerns the physical safety or security of drivers, vehicles, pedestrians or property. The personal information you provide is classified by 18 U.S.C. § 2721 and Minn. Stat. § 168.346 and is subject to the disclosure in accordance with these laws. I am filing this private data request for the safety of my family or myself. I understand that my name and/or residence address will be classified as private data and will not be released to anyone except, law enforcement agencies, probation and parole agencies, and child support enforcement as defined by Minn. Stat. § 168.346(3). The service of process address I provided is a valid, existing address, and I consent to receive service of process and notices pertaining to the vehicle at this address. The service of process address will be used in place of the residence address for dissemination in accordance with 18 U.S.C. § 2721

PERMISSIBLE USES OF MOTOR VEHICLE DATA AS PROVIDED IN 18 U. S. C. TITLE 18 § 2721

- For use by any government agency, including any court or law enforcement agency, in carrying out its functions, or any private person or entity acting
 on behalf of a federal, state, or local agency in carrying out its functions.
- For use in connection with matters of motor vehicle or driver safety and theft; motor vehicle emissions; motor vehicle product alterations, recalls, or
 advisories; performance monitoring of motor vehicles, motor vehicle parts, and dealers; motor vehicle market research activities, including survey
 research; and removal of non-owner records from the original owner records of motor vehicle manufacturers.
- For use in the normal course of business by a legitimate business or its agents, employees, or contractors, but only:
- (A) to verify the accuracy of personal information submitted by the individual to the business or its agencies, employees, or contractors; and
- (B) if such information as so submitted is not correct or is no longer correct, to obtain correct information, but only for the purposes of preventing fraud by, pursuing legal remedies against, or recovering on a debt or security interest against, the individual.
- For use in connection with any civil, criminal, administrative, or arbitral proceeding in any federal, state, or local court or agency or before any self-regulatory body, including the service of process, investigation in anticipation of litigation, and the execution or enforcement of judgments and orders, or pursuant to an order of a federal, state, or local court.
- For use in research activities, and for use in producing statistical reports, so long as the personal information is not published, re-disclosed, or used to contact individuals.
- For use by any insurer or insurance support organization, or by a self-insured entity, or its agents, employees, or contractors, in connection with claims investigation activities, antifraud activities, rating, or underwriting.
- For use in providing notice to the owners of towed or impounded vehicles.
- · For use by any licensed private investigative agency or licensed security service for any purpose permitted under this subsection.
- For use by an employer or its agent or insurer to obtain or verify information relating to a holder of a commercial driver's license that is required under the Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Act, 49 U.S.C. §§ 31301-31317.
- · For use in connection with the operation of private toll transportation facilities.
- For any other use in response to requests for individual motor vehicle records if the state has obtained the express consent of the person to whom such personal information pertains.
- For bulk distribution for surveys, marketing, or solicitations if the state has obtained the express consent of the person to whom such personal information pertains.
- · For use by any requester, if the requester demonstrates it has obtained the written consent of the individual to whom the information pertains.
- For any other use specifically authorized under the law of the state that holds the record, if such use is related to the operation of a motor vehicle or public safety.
